

## REPORTING A SAFEGUARDING CONCERN WITHIN THE BOXING ENVIRONMENT

What to do if you are concerned that a young person is being abused.

Concerned about the safety of yourself or another child at your local boxing club or during camps, competitions



If the child requires immediate medical attention, call an ambulance and inform the doctor there is a child protection concern



Report your concern to Laura Ross, BABA Lead Safeguarding Officer on 0114 223 5613, [safeguarding@gbboxing.org.uk](mailto:safeguarding@gbboxing.org.uk) . Make a note of anything the young person has said, and what you have seen with dates and times. **Every effort will be made to ensure that confidentiality is maintained for all concerned.**



If you cannot get hold of the above staff member and the concern is urgent call Local Authority Children's Services Department/Police immediately.
